The Warblers Club is a men's choral group that has it roots in the original Warblers Club of Woodlawn High School in Birmingham, Alabama, which existed from 1929 until 1977. Many of the current, active performers were members of the Woodlawn High Warblers during their high school days.

The current, active performing group numbers approximately forty-five men, of all age groups, who regularly perform for numerous civic, religious, charitable and commercial functions

Music performed by the Warblers includes a large repertoire of traditional, spiritual, religious, patriotic and popular Broadway choral numbers, and is usually held in a large venue in the Birmingham area. These major shows typically draw audiences ranging to thousands of people. Most of the musical numbers performed by the Warblers were written and/or arranged by Warblers.

About The Evelyn S. Hardy Men of Distinction Male Chrous of Sixth Avenue Baptist Church:

Mrs. Evelyn S. Hardy organized The Sixth Avenue Baptist Church male chorus in 1978 for the church's first observance of brotherhood Sunday at the request of Dr. John Thomas Porter. In 1995, Mrs. Hardy made a suggestion to have a chorus concert and also began a series of concerts that warmed the hearts of the congregation, community and many other music lovers in the Birmingham area.

The male chorus has rendered praise in Texas, North Carolina, Georgia and many appearances in the city of Birmingham and state of Alabama. For many years, William "Bill" Harris directed the chorus and served until God called him home. After 35 years Mrs. Hardy retired. To honor her, in December of 2013, the male chorus was officially renamed the *Evelyn S. Hardy Men of Distinction Male Chorus of Sixth Avenue Baptist Church*. March 2014, marked a new beginning as the direction and leadership was bestowed upon the dynamic and energetic Mr. Vedric E. Shelby also known as the "*Maestro*". Mr. David Talley IV is the official accompanist. The Men of Distinction has rendered praise during the National Baptist Convention, Alabama State Baptist Convention, the National Gospel Music Workshop of America Conference and many other events that have social, spiritual and political significance.

It is the mission of the Evelyn. S Hardy Men of Distinction Male Chorus to exalt the human spirit through Biblically based, innovative and engaging music as we equip and empower the Saints to do the work of ministry for the strengthening of the church.

The History of WOODISCOVERY CLUBS

King Solomon stated that God "has set eternity in the hearts of men." If you ask one of our Discovery Clubs volunteers, they may tell you that they see eternity in the eyes of the hundreds of boys and girls in Birmingham. Week after week, well-trained volunteers wear their yellow vests and teach Jesus in public schools across the Birmingham Metro area. Discovery Clubs is the most direct form of evangelism and discipleship, making a Kingdom impact on unchurched children in Birmingham.

How did Discovery Clubs begin? In 1994, Mr. John Glasser founded Better Basics, an in-school literacy tutoring program available in 20 Alabama counties. As the reading program expanded to more public school children, Mr. Glasser realized that most of these children had never been in a church nor heard the Gospel. As a result, Mr. Glasser's burden for these children began to grow.

A U.S. Supreme Court ruling in 2001 allowed public school principals to invite organizations into their school building before and after regular school hours. The ruling enabled Mr. Glasser to start Discovery Clubs, whose first club met at Gate City Elementary in 2003 with 40 children and 14 volunteers from Mr. Glasser's church.

Today, Discovery Clubs has grown to 25 schools with 60 clubs in those schools. We have 1,200 students enrolled so far. Discovery Clubs is a Birmingham Metro Baptist Association ministry with supporters from many biblically-faithful churches throughout the city of Birmingham and the surrounding counties. Would you join us in taking Jesus to the next generation? Children in our public schools need you now more than ever!
